1<sup>st</sup> R. P. 298 to C. Partridge, Lots 108 and 109 which were sold to H. J. Ray in 1881 and conveyed by J. F. Colburn to above person and wife in 1884, and by them to W. Maertens.

2<sup>nd</sup> R. P. 371 to McNeill, lot 150. No record of transfer by McNeill, this lot is now occupied by Mr. Burgess, but does not claim title.

3<sup>rd</sup> R. P. 304 to Jonas M. Byram, Lots 131 and 132. These lots were sold to F. Bartels by John C. Byram.
