Informing her that the Deed from Kamehameha III & H. Kapa-kuhaili of the Ili of Kahapaakai, more legal weight than a Royal Patent for the reason that they sold to her a Crown land & Royal Patents are only intended for land on Land Commission Awards & other Konohiki lands in order that the Govt's. interest therein maybe set aside. It was during the reign of Kamehameha IV that a bill was passed prohibiting the sale of Crown Lands, &c
