<p>In letter from the Attorney General to the Min. of Interior rendering his opinion on the question as enumerated on his letter of May 11th as to the propriety of granting a royal patent of the Maemae Premises, (Kawananakoa) occupied by the above party, that in 1848, Kekuanakoa as guardian of V. Kamamalu, in possession of the land, parted with his rights by the Great Mahele of said year by which Kamehameha III became the owner.
