This story of the Lahaina Mission premises is based on material gathered by Arthur C. Alexander, a grandson of the missionary, Dr. Baldwin, from early letters, journals and reports of the missionaries, reports of the American Board, reports of the Seamen's Friend Society, and testimony before the Land Commission. It covers the successive occupancy of the Lahaina Mission from 1823 to 1871 by the six missionaries who were connected with the erection of its buildings: Charles Stewart, William Richards, Lorrin Andrews, Dr. Alonzo Chapin, Ephraim Spaulding and Dr. Dwight Baldwin.
