Acknowledging receipt of His Majesty's autograph letter presented to Peruvian Govt. Nov. 12th. Expresses pleasure over treaties signed by Hawaii with Great Britain. Sympathy expressed by British and American Ministers to Hawaii re her quarrel with France. Gives her an exalted political position. Conduct of France overbearing. Suggested to British & American Naval Commanders propriety of establishing part of their forces at Hawaii. That above person, suggested propriety of Consul asking interposition of friendly powers to protect Hawaii, & c. Commodore McAnley expressed favor of Hawaiian Independence. May visit Hawaii.
