Wants him to publish in paretlet columns 500 copies of General Miller's "Fictitious Speech" and G.P. Judd's Real Report to the Legislature of 1845. Refers to Miller's insulting letters virtually charging them all as being such dishonest, thievish and corrupt men, that the State will go to distruction unless there is an Auditor to scrutinize their accounts. Mr. Wyllie's headings for the paretlet columns and his strong defence of Mr. Judd. Suggests that copies be sent to the Editors of the leading papers of New York and London. U.S. Commissioners Gregg's discourtesy will not be approved of by Mr. Marcy.
