"Anthony Allen the colored man who has resided at Waikiki ever since the establishment of the Mission & kept a house of entertainment, was buried this afternoon. He died of apoplexy on Thursday evening (Dec. 31).

He arrived at the islands I learn in the year 1810 -
He was formerly a slave of a gentleman in the city of Albany I think. It is supposed he has considerable property. His daughter was married a few days ago to a white man who has been working for some time with Mr. Colcord engaged in making shoes."
