Gov. Kekuanaoa to John Young, Premier

Statting that he has informed Ahulike and Kaomali, who murdered Kawaa, that in pursuance of the verdict of the jury, rendered May 19, 1846, that they will be hanged at the Fort, Friday, August 14, 1846. Kaomali has been examined and is not with child as claimed by her.

Same to Same.

July 14

Stating he has received instructions from the King, that the above are to be hanged between the hours of 10 AM and 1 PM. Has given instructions that they be hanged at noon.
