The Commission was created by Act 181, Session Laws, 1923, and is charged with the duty of planning a uniform system of accounting, a system of recording statistical data, and a system of reporting financial and other statistical data, and on the approval of the Governor, to cause such systems to be installed and used in the offices of the Territory of Hawaii; and of the counties of the Territory of Hawaii, and of cities of the Territory of Hawaii.
