Dear Sir: Yours of 1st inst. is at hand. In reply to your inquiries, I find on my record that on Oct 2, 1862, I married Kaipulehua (K) to Kamakaia (W). But I fail to find therein the names of Peniaia (K) + Kaahaina (W). I received a license to "celebrate" marriages from Prince Lut Kamehameha, Min of Interior, about the 1st of Feb. 1861, & from that time until I left Kinau I married over 100 couples. I don't know what became of my license, and strange to say, the present clerks in the Interior Department can find no record of its having been issued, nor of the list of marriages which I forwarded to the Department.

On the other page I give a certificate for Kaipulehua & Kamakaia.
